



## Orange County Utilities Department Variance Application for Landscape Irrigation on Alternative Day(s)

On February 23, 2010, in order to comply with the St. Johns River and South Florida Water Management Districts, Orange County has adopted Water Conservation Ordinance No. 2010-02 limiting the number of days irrigation can occur each week depending on **Eastern Standard Time** (from the first Sunday in November until the second Sunday in March) and **Daylight Saving Time** (from the second Sunday in March until the first Sunday in November). This ordinance applies to landscape irrigation regardless of whether the water comes from groundwater or surface water, from a private well or pump, or from a public or private utility.

This form can be used by Orange County Utilities water customers to request an alternative day(s) that watering can occur every week based on whether the property is a home with an address that ends with an even or odd number, or the property is nonresidential (including common areas of subdivisions). **Orange County Utilities cannot grant additional days per week to irrigate.**

A healthy lawn and landscaping can typically be maintained by following the landscape irrigation schedules set forth in the ordinance. Additional information and helpful yard-care tips can be found on our website at [www.occonservewater.net](http://www.occonservewater.net).

No petition for variance shall be granted unless the petitioner affirmatively demonstrates that strict application of the scheduled days or day would lead to unreasonable or unfair results in particular instances, provided that the applicant demonstrates with particularity that compliance with the scheduled days or day will result in a substantial economic, health or other hardship on the applicant requesting the variance or those served by the applicant.

**All information on this form MUST be completely filled out to be considered.**

**Upon approval, the variance will expire one year from the date the form is submitted. Applicant must then submit another request if so desired.**
